1	40% Students feel they are not industry ready. In addition , 30% Faculties feel the students are not ready to face industry requirements	Along with industry initiatives like “ Amar Sathi ” Program , increased focus on Hands-on Courses and Workshops on Modern Contemporary Practice based topics. Courses with Live Demonstrations and Recorded Video Demonstrations were conducted on Implants for Beginners, SPEAK International Dental Conference , O-3 Knowledge Symposium , Dental Materials Foundation Course , Interactive Radiology and Practice Management.
2	95% Alumni feels BDS syllabus needs modifications.	The higher CO's which are neglected in conventional dental teaching were focused on by mandatory Case Discussions in Clinical Postings for Final Years and Interns taken every Monday and Friday from 1:45 pm to 2:45 pm.
3	26% Professionals feel students are not future ready and not upto date with the industry advances.	Wide spectrum of addon courses catered to enhanced exposure for graduates and PGs for 2023-24. In addition , majority of faculties were trained for use of AI , Interactive Learning , Simulation Learning Tools and Softwares in Treatment Planning in Dentistry by IQAC.



4	40% Employers feel the outgoing professionals lack ethical & social responsibility.	The thrust on AETCOM skill courses has been increased significantly from range of programs to increased funding. Ethics , Communication Skills , E-Learning , Legal Jurisprudence , Gender Issues and Financial Health were all covered by programs and quality initiatives in 2024. Students of all batches participated actively in the Doctors Agitation for Justice in the Abhaya RG Kar Case , in addition to holding Abhaya Clinics for patient services.
